AT QANTAS worth voting for

Qantas Catering Ballot to start Monday 29th August

TWU Qantas Catering staff covered by EBA VII will start receiving their ballot papers in the mail on Monday 29th August.

If you have not received your ballot papers by Thursday 1st September contact Mario from the Australian Electoral Commission on (02) 9579 3613. He will work with you to get you the chance to have your vote count.

Vote YES to protected action

Qantas have rejected every core part of our claim and now we must show them we are serious about entitlements, wages, job security and safety at work.

Remember: Once the ballot is successful all TWU members will be legally protected to have the option for protest action

Our Claim	Qantas' Response
Single Agreement at Qantas to protect all TWU members	REJECTED
Real access to an Independent Umpire for workplace disputes	REJECTED
Port Rates: Same rates of pay for the same work, so there is no incentive to outsource your job to outside hire	REJECTED
Job Security and a safer workplace	REJECTED
5% pay rise per year with an additional 1% in superannuation, protected against surges in CPI	NO COMMENT

What steps do I have to take to vote YES?

Step 1:
Receive ballot paper in the mail

Step 2:
Vote YES, place ballot paper in envelope and sign envelope

Do you, for the purposes of supporting or advancing claims in respect of a proposed Enterprise Agreement with Qantas Airways Limited, authorise the taking of industrial action against Qantas Airways Limited, which is authorised by ballot, in the form of:

- The performance of work in a manner different from that which it is customarily performed
- Bans and limitations on job functions
- Higher duties bans
- Overtime bans and limitations
- Paperwork bans
- Work to rule
- Stop work meeting
- Work stoppages of up to four (4) hours
- Twenty-four (24) hour work stoppages
- Forty-eight (48) hour work stoppages

Such protected industrial action to be taken separately, concurrently and/or consecutively over the duration of the negotiation for a Transport Workers Union Qantas Airways Limited Enterprise Agreement.

Step 3:
Post back before 9th September
