The TWU's independent contractor delegate team met in Sydney on 10 October for the first round of negotiations.

The TWU delegate-led team presented the following core claims:

- Improved job security;
- Consultation over major change;
- Clearer provisions on rate increases;
- Pay parity for contractors Australia-wide;
- Clearer dispute resolution; and
- Flexibility and certainty for alternate drivers.

Star Track tabled its counter-claim:

- Uniform 9 hour minimum engagements;
- Looking to introduce incentive payment scheme;
- Right to audit contractors; and
- Extending holiday period hours.
