

# FIGHT FOR SAFE ROADS



Every year, hundreds of people are killed in truck crashes. Two years ago the Federal Government shut down an independent watchdog investigating safety in trucking.

The problem starts at the top of the supply chain.

When wealthy retailers, like Aldi, squeeze transport, drivers are pressured to work longer hours, speed and skip mandatory rest breaks to get the job done.

But no one is holding these companies to account. Truck drivers cop all the blame.
