STOP THE RACE TO THE BOTTOM IN AVIATION

You've seen the pictures showing how Aerocare workers are forced to sleep at airports because of low wages and split shifts. Well aviation bosses want to force ALL airport workers on to these conditions.

On Thursday 6th April two new companies - Dnata's Airport Handling Services Australia and Altara's Aviation Ground Resources – will try to get dodgy agreements approved by the Fair Work Commission. These agreements declare war on the wages and conditions of every Australian airport worker.

The TWU will be inside the Commission to try to knock off these sub-standard agreements. But we have no guarantees of success.



DOES THIS AFFECT YOU?

Yes it does. The move by Dnata to establish agreements with lower than award rates of pay, reduced weekend penalties, reduced shift penalties and a guarantee of only 60 hours a month has the potential to give them a massive cost advantage over other airport service providers.

If successful your company will be demanding that you accept the same conditions just to keep your job.

HOW CAN I HELP?

Come to the Fair Work Commission.

The TWU and the ASU are asking all available airport workers to come to the Fair Work Commission to rally against the approval of these agreements.
