Thank you for your letter to Perth Airport Chairman, Mr Colin Beckett, dated 2 June 2017, in relation to an alleged breach of airside security at Perth Airport.

Perth Airport places the highest priority on the safety and security of workers, passengers and visitors at our airport and we are proud of our record in this regard.

Perth Airport has a multi-layered approach to security with a range of measures and procedures applied to maintain security at the Airport. All organisations operating at our Airport are required to comply with these security measures and procedures.

Unfortunately, other than in compliance with the reporting requirements outlined in the *Aviation Transport Security Act 2004*, Perth Airport does not provide information to third parties on alleged breaches of security or on specific security measures and procedures employed at the airport.

I am therefore unable to provide to you the information requested in your letter.

I trust this information satisfies your requirements at this point in time.
