IN-PRINCIPLE AGREEMENT AND A WIN FOR CONTRACTORS AT STARTRACK

After 8 months of standing strong and united, your delegate-led bargaining team have reached inprinciple agreement with StarTrack.

We have fought off StarTrack's attacks on the terms of your agreement and minimum hours for an even stronger agreement in 2019.

THROUGH THE WORK OF MEMBERS STANDING TOGETHER WE HAVE FOUGHT FOR AND WON:

- 5 year agreement
- Retention of the current cost model locking in your hourly rates of pay
- Confirmation you will receive the OTR reward bonus payment next year if the bonus targets are achieved
- Locked in minimum 9 hour contracts with 10 hours locked in for current SA contractors!
- New consultation clauses giving contractors a voice at StarTrack
- Annual consultative committee meetings
- Redundancy process provisions
- Blue card training provisions
- Improved assignment provisions giving you more flexibility in your business
- Increased vehicle age provisions allowing you to keep your vehicle for up to 10 years
- Improved access to the alternate driver pool

OTHER CHANGES TO CONSIDER:

- Change to the black-out period (now until 6 January)
- New rostering system to ensure leave is properly managed over the busy end of year block-out period
