## TOLL HIT BY SECOND CYBER ATTACK

The TWU has been informed that Toll has been hit by a second cyber attack.

The attack has again forced the shut down of Toll electronic systems, meaning possible disruptions to payments to all employees and sub-contractors.

Whilst the full extent of the attack and its implications are not yet known the TWU will continue to seek regular updates from Toll on the impact, and the likely length of time that it will take to have systems up and running again.

In the meantime the TWU advises all employees and tied sub-contractors to:

- Maintain a diary record of all work completed until further notice
- Maintain all Toll work records, rosters, etc

This will help ensure any payments can be reconciled to you when systems are back online.

As more information comes to light the TWU will update members.
