QANTAS REDUNDANCIES: WHAT WE KNOW SO FAR

Qantas' announcement that at least 6,000 workers will be made redundant came without consultation with unions and without first speaking to workers before announcing to press.

We are urgently seeking information from Qantas, but are yet to receive any evidence to justify the 6,000 job losses, particularly when Alan Joyce previously announced the financial stability to sustain the company for two years.

WHAT WE'VE BEEN TOLD SO FAR:

- Right now we are being told there will be 957 job losses across the QAL and QGS Group (not
 including freight), but this is subject to consultation with the union and delegates
- We're told to expect little to no job losses in Jetstar Ground, but there may be some in Jetstar cabin crew
- At least 1,200 positions remain stood down
- Qantas has confirmed voluntary redundancies will be called for in the first instance
