Scott Morrison today announced an extension to JobKeeper but failed to apply the scheme to all aviation workers who've been without pay for months.

For weeks TWU delegates and officials have been pushing Dnata management for urgent answers. It is critical that the company provides us with a plan for its workforce in Australia.

We will continue to demand answers on the financial support Dnata and Emirates will provide to their workers and their plan for a fair redundancy process.

Delegates have established a working group to start immediate discussions with Dnata around the redundancy process and will be asking for calculations around entitlements to be provided along with a clear process stepped out for those who want to consider redundancies.

Any redundancy process has to be voluntary, fair, transparent and provide certainty. TWU delegates and officials have consistently reminded Dnata of this and will continue to until a fair process is in place.
