WE VOTED **NO**, now let's get back to the table!

Congratulations on successfully voting NO to Cameron's substandard deal. It's been almost one week since the ballot closed, a ballot which demonstrated that when workers stand strong together, management has no choice but to listen.

WHY WON'T CAMERON PROVIDE THE FINAL VOTE RESULT?

Your bargaining committee has approached Cameron on a number of occasions to ask for the formal and final ballot results, but this has not been provided. Instead of talking to your bargaining committee to discuss the next steps and when to get back to the bargaining table, Cameron began conducting an anonymous survey as if the NO Vote outcome was not enough. This is a classic management divide and conquer tactic.

Because of the successful NO Vote result, expect management to up the ante – this may come in many forms including talking to each of you individually or as a group, asking you to fill in an anonymous survey, use language which excludes your bargaining committee or refer to them as third party and many more.

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- ✓ When this happens, the best thing workers can do is to **tell management to get back to the negotiating table** and meet with your bargaining committee.
- ✓ If you feel you or your workmates are being coerced or pressured, contact your TWU delegate or organiser immediately.
- ✓ If you're not yet a member, join the TWU and tell your mates to join too.

Management knows our strength lies in standing together collectively and speaking with one voice. Join us in telling Cameron to **get back to the negotiation table**.
