

TWU AND VIRGIN PILOTS UNION BEGIN TALKS ON AMALGAMATION

After standing strong together during the Virgin administration process, the TWU and the Association for Virgin Group Pilots (VIPA), are signing a memorandum of understanding with the intention of moving towards amalgamation.

The reason for the amalgamation is to strengthen our collective voices in Virgin and to fight for the survival of the aviation industry.

Both the TWU and VIPA are fighting to help make Virgin the strong second airline again that Australia needs. This can only be achieved through Virgin's dedicated and well trained workforce. By coming together we can make a strong case for high standards and work to protect the interests of those who matter most: Virgin workers and the travelling public.

An amalgamation would also allow workers from both unions to strongly pressure the Federal Government to do more to support Virgin and the rest of the aviation industry.

When the memorandum of understanding is signed both unions will kick-off talks on details on the merger of both unions over the coming weeks.
