Dear Mr Kaine,

Thank you for your letter dated 4 February 2020 regarding the protection of our staff with regards to the coronavirus.

The health and safety of our people is our number one priority and we have undertaken multiple layers of protective measures in alignment with Federal and State Government health advice.

The Australian Government announced that effectively immediately, foreign nationals (excluding permanent residents) who are in mainland China will not be allowed to enter Australia for 14 days from the time they have left or transited through mainland China. This is a temporary measure which will be reviewed in 14 days. The travel advisory for all of mainland China has also been raised to Level Four – “Do not travel”.

In summary, Adelaide Airport Ltd's (AAL) actions are as follows:

- We are following Australian Government Medical and Border Security advice.
- A Project Control Group has been established by AAL with Department of Agriculture, Federal Department of Health and State Department of Health to ensure co-ordination.
- Stocks of face masks, sanitizer and gloves have been purchased and these have been made available to staff. AAL is mandating wearing protective equipment when called to attend to a medical emergency with respiratory symptoms and has also recommended wearing protective equipment if attending the quarantine border zone. AAL has communicated to all of our staff that protective equipment is available on request.

It should be noted AAL staff generally have little operational need to attend the quarantine border zone.

Our measures are under constant review to ensure the protection of our staff and customers.
