Thank you to all the TWU members and workers at Border Express who participated in the union's recent bargaining survey. This first step in bargaining is critical in assisting the TWU to develop the log of claims which will be presented to management.

You told us the issues that matter to you and these are what we're giving the utmost importance:

- Bargaining to commence for replacement agreement
- Job security
- Full utilisation
- Superannuation increase (1% first year, 1.5% second year)
- Wage increases of 6% per year
- Fair rostering
- Paid breaks
- Health and safety
- Paid pandemic leave
- EA expiry 30 June 2023
- Delegates' rights, including establishment of consultative committee

Many of you told us that while the Border Express work has increased overall during the pandemic, you are concerned that the company will use the pandemic to attack your wages and conditions.
