

AVIATION JOBS AT RISK: EMAIL SCOMO TODAY



The Federal Government is ripping away the JobKeeper lifeline that has kept thousands of aviation workers in their jobs.

Taxpayers have supported these jobs all year and just as aviation hopes to get back on its feet, the support is being pulled. Subsidised flights to some locations provides no guarantees for job security and fails to support workers to pay bills.

Not only that, magically all but one of the discounted flights is to a marginal or Liberal-held seat.

This is a disgraceful continuation of the Federal Government's refusal to listen to workers, instead catering to big business and its own political self-interests.

This will be a disaster. It will mean a serious threat to jobs. It will mean a devastating loss of skills to the industry.

We are asking you to get involved to let the Government know that this is the wrong move.

We must keep fighting to keep workers in jobs and prevent a loss of skills to the industry.
