Today Australia Post has announced its 2021 Financial Year results. As expected, your hard work throughout the pandemic has smashed records for the company:

New record revenue of \$8.27 billion StarTrack volumes up 12.1 per cent

In the same email to workers, CEO Rodney Boys thanks everyone "for all your hard work in delivering for Australia."

Only recently, it was also revealed that in the 2019-2020 financial year, Australia Post senior staff were given almost **\$92 million in bonuses.**

The company was also found to have underpaid 19,500 former workers about \$1.8 million.
