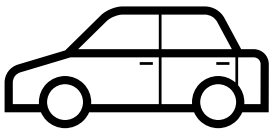


AMAZON FLEX SURVEY



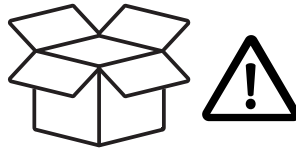
A survey of around 250 Amazon Flex drivers has revealed serious safety concerns, bullying by management and pressures to rush.

SAFETY CONCERNS



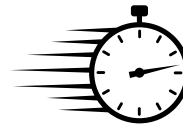
73%

45%

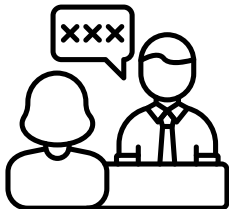
were forced to deliver heavy boxes alone

TOXIC CULTURE



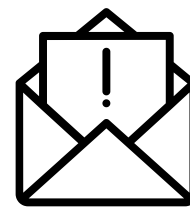
1 in 6
