



# STRIKES TO GO AHEAD

After your delegates endorsed a 24-hour Australia-wide BevChain strike this week, we have made significant progress with the company on your job security claims. **But BevChain has still not come to the table on several of our key claims, and your delegates have endorsed a strike on Thurs 21 Oct from midnight to midnight.**

Linfox, StarTrack and FedEx today will also be notifying strike action for next week, and we are preparing for an industry stoppage if the companies don't settle the outstanding issues.
