



STRIKES TO GO AHEAD

After your delegates endorsed a 24-hour Australia-wide Linfox strike last week, we have made significant progress with the company on your job security claims. **But Linfox has still not come to the table on several of our key claims, and your delegates have endorsed a strike on Thurs 21 Oct from midnight to midnight.**

Bevchain, FedEx and StarTrack today will also be notifying strike action for next week, and we are preparing for an industry stoppage if the companies don't settle the outstanding issues.

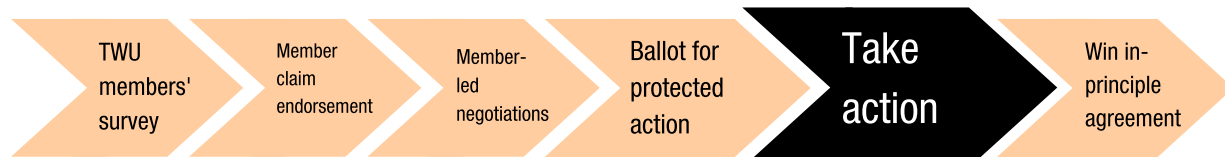
KEY WINS THROUGHOUT THIS CAMPAIGN
