# SURVEY RESULTS ARE IN

Thank you to the over 1500 workers who filled out the survey on reinstatement and compensation. **A massive 78% of you have opted for reinstatement.**

The survey will now be used as evidence in the Federal Court to help the Judge determine whether Qantas should be ordered to offer workers your jobs back.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** if you did not get a chance to fill in the survey, you will still be included in any remedy ordered by the judge if you are eligible. You are eligible if you were covered by the Qantas or QGS EA for workers in baggage, ramp, push-back driving or fleet presentation, and were made compulsorily redundant as part of the decision to outsource on 30th November 2020. If you're unsure about your eligibility, please contact your delegate, organiser or TWU branch.
