SCOTT'S TO CEASE OPERATIONS

Despite all best efforts to try and secure a new owner, it was announced today that the company will cease its operations and will not be able to continue to employ its workforce.

For now, you must continue to go to work until you are told you are no longer required to ensure you get redundancy entitlements.

The TWU will support you through this difficult process and make sure that employees have access to their entitlements under the Fair Entitlement Guarantee (FEG) such as unpaid wages, redundancy payments, annual leave, RDOs, Long Service Leave, and notice pay.



Your union will be working to achieve redeployment opportunities with other transport operators where possible, pushing clients and operators to commit to prioritising you. TWU leadership, industrial officers, organisers and delegates will be supporting you every step of the way.

We need urgent transport reform!

Scott's is Australia's largest cold chain operator and there is no direct competitor. Its collapse is a tragedy originated from a supply chain crisis caused by wealthy clients like Aldi squeezing transport contracts and profiting off the razor-thin margins of operators.

A crisis like this highlights the importance of the Federal Parliament urgently passing reform to make transport work fairer, safe and more sustainable.
