QANTAS ANNOUNCES RECORD PROFITS

Today Qantas has announced a mammoth \$2.5 billion in profits - a record for the airline. These profits come off the back of:

- Illegally outsourcing 1700 workers
- Splintering its workforce into 38 entities and labour hire providers
- Receiving \$2.7 billion in taxpayer funding from the Morrison Government during the pandemic, with no strings attached
- **Price-gouging** the public
- · Continuing to attack workers

Alan Joyce is stepping down as CEO at the end of the year, but he's still got a lot of questions to answer from his time at Qantas, which has seen standards for workers devastated.

Qantas must treat workers as an investment rather than as a cost, and be accountable for ALL workers in its supply chain.
