BARGAINING UPDATE

Discussions have commenced with Menzies management to set up a process for negotiations.

YOU'VE TOLD US YOU WANT ONE NATIONAL AGREEMENT

In October we circulated the results of TWU member surveys, including that members overwhelmingly support fighting for a **single national agreement**. We know that:

- Members are stronger when fighting together
- A single national agreement is the best way to lift and protect standards

On this basis, the TWU has not agreed to enter into separate bargains across Australia. This would play into a managerial tactic to divide and conquer and rush bargains through. We've made this clear to Menzies, and the unity and coordination of delegates and members to not be rushed into separate weaker agreements has been commendable.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

• We encourage all members to state the positions clearly and tell management to get to the bargaining table. Menzies is the last major ground company or airline to have scattered agreements which leave workers in a weaker position to push for better standards.

In the middle of a cost of llving crisis Menzies needs to come to the table, agree to a process with a delegate-led TWU bargaining team and start national discussions for a fair agreement that delivers:
