

VIRGIN APPLIES FOR MORE AUSTRALIA-INDONESIA FLIGHTS






In December 2023, Virgin applied to the International Air Services Commission to add **new international routes**:

WORK NEEDS TO BE DONE

Delegates and members have raised issues regarding current flights between Australia and Indonesia.

We have flagged with Virgin that the company needs to work with.

-  TWU Cabin Crew delegates and HSRs to ensure **Perth – Denpasar flights are a safe environment** to work in and possible improvements that can be made
-  TWU pilot delegates to **improve accommodation options in Bali** and ensure protections around duty lengths, minimising multi-city pairings
-  Both delegate groups to ensure that **adequate rest periods are rostered** so minimum rest periods are not encroached by network delays
