

BORDER EXPRESS UPDATE FEBRUARY 2024

FIRST WIN IN ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT BARGAINING

Your member-led TWU bargaining committee met with Border Express (BEX) management on 13 December, where **we secured backpay commitments** to 9 December 2023.

Backpay is a **massive win** for workers at Border Express. When you stick together with a common goal in mind, you can achieve excellent outcomes.



WHAT WORKERS WANT

- An expiry date of **30 June 2026** to make the transport industry's future more sustainable.
- Outside hire conversion the right to convert to permanent after 6 months.
- Casuals to convert to permanent after 3 months.
- **TWU induction** the right for new employees to talk with the TWU about member benefits.
- Improved consultation rights management must consult with employees before introducing any major change.
- Consultative Committee to deal with workplace issues reasonably and promptly.
- **Superannuation** Pathway to the 15% industry standard.
- **Paid meal breaks** for shift workers
- **Pay increase:** 15%-19% over the life of the agreement.
- Same Job, Same Pay
- Job security Paid yard meetings
