

NATIONAL CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE UPDATE



Your TWU National Committee met with StarTrack management representatives on 22-23rd May in Sydney as part of your consultation rights in the TWU-StarTrack Enterprise Agreement (EA).

Your committee utilised this process to address the following important issues raised by members.

OUTSOURCING OF WORK

'Streaming' is a polite word for outsourcing your work to cheaper labour like AusPost or outside hire. Outsourcing attacks your job security and take-home pay. We must stand strong together to hold StarTrack to account for this.

OTHER ISSUES RAISED:

- Payroll errors
- Insufficient number of driver trainers
- Lengthy Comcare workers' compensation approval process
- Manual handling policy needed for heavy parcels 32kgs+
- Public holiday payment after an absence
- Inconsistent compassionate leave entitlements
- Bargaining in 2024 – the renegotiation of the TWU-StarTrack agreements
