



## TEAM JETSTAR AGREEMENT VARIATION - VOTE YES

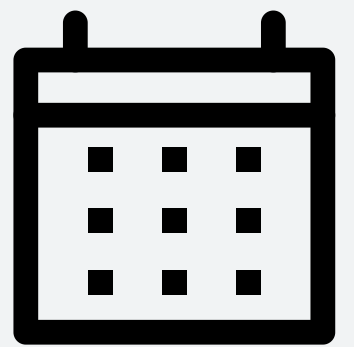
**Voting will soon open on your Agreement variation which will deliver pay increases for all that better reflect equitable remuneration between you and JQD.**

### KEY WINS

- ✓ Missed meal break payment of \$21 (increased from \$16)
- ✓ BOC payment of \$117.43 per BOC duty (to be increased as per JQ rates each year)  
(BOC to be defined as an operational flying duty consisting of 2 or more operated sectors, starting and ending at a Jetstar crew base, signing on before midnight local time and signing off after 0300 or later local time.)
- ✓ New unused accommodation payment of \$67.53 per day (excluding international)
- ✓ TJ casuals to receive a 1:2 credit payment on unused home standby periods. Current 1:4 credit payment on used standby period as provided in the Jetstar agreement
- ✓ Jetstar to fulfil obligations on part-time conversions by June '25

**This is in addition to gains from initial discussions including:**

- ✓ Increase of \$3 per block hour to each existing TJ flying allowances
- ✓ Increase to TJ cabin crew base salaries
- ✓ Back pay to 1 November 2024
