Thanks to all affected Qantas workers for your ongoing patience as we work through the complex process of compensation.

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

- The Court has now made orders which will enable the Settlement Distribution Scheme to commence.
- Maurice Blackburn, which will administer the fund, must now receive the compensation amount from Qantas within 14 days.
- From then, the process for settlement will commence. We'll provide further updates as soon as we can.
