In great news for Rex workers, we are recommencing bargaining for your ground Enterprise Agreement with EY, the Rex administrator.

Before the company collapsed, we were making strong progress in negotiations. That progress was put on hold in a period of great uncertainty and stress for Rex workers. But thanks to your unity and determination, bargaining is back on track to finally lock in the fair deal you deserve.

OUTSTANDING ISSUES

EY has confirmed they will honour the progress made before the collapse, and we are now pressing on outstanding issues, including:

- ▶ Fair pay increases
- Improved redundancy
- 20% loading for shifts starting prior to7.00am and shifts finishing after 6.00pm
- Union inductions
- Improved redundancy
- ▶ 20% loading for shifts starting prior to 7.00am and shifts finishing after 6.00pm

- Since the terrible collapse, we have made huge steps to rebuild Rex and save jobs & services:
 - Federal Govt to Buy REX if No Buyer is Found: After months of pressure from your TWU team, this is a huge first step toward protecting your jobs and ensuring the future of Rex.
 - Rex to Continue Flying: Ensures continued support for an essential regional airline service while bringing much-needed certainty to your careers as Rex workers.
