

WIN: DNATA BACKS DOWN ON PAY FREQUENCY CHANGE

This week, your TWU-led bargaining committee met with dnata Catering management. Thanks to the pressure of TWU members, dnata has agreed to **not change the frequency of your pay** to a weekly pay cycle. Workers will continue to be paid fortnightly.

This is a direct result of workers' pressure — and shows what we can achieve when we do when we stand together as one.

But the fight isn't over yet.



WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

- ▶ We have started consultation with dnata about the “**roster alignment**” change. Your representatives made it very clear to the company: **workers do not support these changes.**
- ▶ We've told dnata that they need to provide details about **how roster alignment will impact your current rosters.**

WHAT'S NEXT?

- We will continue to consult with dnata Catering management to ensure **your voices are heard** and that the company doesn't **unilaterally make decisions that affects your rosters.**

Let's keep it up and push back against any changes that hurt workers.
