

UPDATE - QANTAS COMPENSATION

We are now ready to progress to the next stage of the compensation process.

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW

- The settlement funds have now been sent from Qantas
- Maurice Blackburn has now set up an online portal to commence the process for administering compensation to affected Qantas employees
- You should have received information from Maurice Blackburn on how to access this portal to so they can commence the process, including asking you for certain information

BASELINE PAYMENT

• All affected workers will receive a baseline payment of \$9,000 after tax, with a further \$1,000 to be paid at a later date and after you sign a deed. Some workers will receive additional compensation based on the principles set out in the Federal Court judgment.

ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION

• To assess if you are entitled to amounts over and above the baseline payment, you will need to provide information regarding your economic loss and/or the impact of the outsourcing decision on you. The kinds of documents you need to produce will be explained to you shortly.
