

OCEANIA **WITHDRAWS** FWC APPLICATION

Oceania has withdrawn its application to the Fair Work Commission for approval of the Enterprise Agreement that members had voted up.

The company have **refused to make a commitment to backpay workers** and give a further increase from 1 July 2025. This delay is the company's fault and the withdrawal of the application is the company's choice. Workers should not have to suffer for Oceania's mistakes.

Oceania needs to immediately address the Commission and the TWU's concerns with the agreement. The company needs to ensure that workers covered by the agreement are better off than if they were on the Award.

We have called for an urgent meeting with Oceania.



NEXT STEPS:

Now that Oceania has withdrawn the EA approval application, the next steps are:

1. The agreement needs to be **redrafted so it can be approved**
2. A **new access period** will then commence
3. You will then need to **vote again** on the revised agreement
4. The Agreement will then **go back to the Commission** for approval
