INDUSTRY STANDARDS AND RECENT WINS

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO YOU

PAY INCREASES

· Fair and decent pay increases. Recently dnata ground workers won pay increases of 6% per year.

 You deserve to be paid fairly for the work you do and increases that address the cost of living crisis and the pressures faced by workers.

SUPERANNUATION

Pathway to 15% super.

You deserve dignity in retirement.

ROSTERING PROTECTIONS

· Improved conditions which address work-life balance concerns, like 2 consecutive days off or maximum 6 shifts in a row.

 You deserve decent rostering practices and a work-life balance.

BREAK PROTECTIONS

 Ensuring meal breaks occur between hours 2-5 of your shift. Where the meal break does not occur, a worker will be paid at double time until they have the break.

You deserve proper breaks that aren't simply taken in the first hour of your shift or tacked on to the end.

LEAVE

 Pathway to 15 days personal leave, 20 days family and domestic violence leave and 10 days delegates leave.

 You deserve fair leave entitlements. and for improved leave for delegates to better represent you.

CONSULTATION

Strong National and Local Consultative Committee structures to facilitate consultation. You deserve proper process for the company and delegates to discuss any changes, issues at work or the implementation of your Agreement.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

 Status quo provisions so that the current work conditions remain the same during a dispute, so nothing changes while issues are resolved.

· You deserve to be protected from sudden changes to pay, hours, or duties while a dispute is being resolved.
