

QANTAS FREIGHT WORKER DEATH

Many of you would be aware of the tragic death of a Wymap worker at Sydney Airport yesterday.

This is a distressing and traumatic incident for many, and TWU officials have been on-site offering support. While investigations are still continuing, we know workers have been speaking up about significant safety concerns in aviation—this tragic incident shows just how urgent change in the industry is.

- Conducting site visits at Sydney Airport to speak to workers about support and your rights, as well as to review safety standards across the supply chain
- Writing to Qantas and SafeWork about the urgent need to investigate safety and training standards at Wymap and across the Qantas supply chain
- Continuing our campaign for a Safe and Secure Skies Commission to hold airlines and airports accountable for safety at work
