



UPDATE - QANTAS COMPENSATION



Here's your latest update on Qantas compensation and penalties following the illegal outsourcing decision.

COMPENSATION STATUS

INITIAL PAYMENTS

- Most affected workers who have signed up to settlement administration have received an initial payment of \$9,000, with a final \$1000 to be paid at the end of the process upon signing a deed.

ECONOMIC LOSS

- If you have signed up for your initial payment, you will also have received a portal link to provide documents to determine your level of economic loss from the outsourcing decision

NON-ECONOMIC LOSS

- There is a further process to determine non-economic loss for pain, hurt and distress. You will receive a link for this portion of the compensation once you have completed the portal for economic loss.

ADDITIONAL WORKER PAYMENTS FROM PENALTY

This week TWU members attended the Federal Court to find out how and when the judge was going to distribute \$40 million in penalty payments to workers. These payments will be on top of the \$120 million in compensation.

WORKERS TO RECEIVE INITIAL PAYMENTS SOON

- The additional penalty payments will be distributed in two waves.
- The first will be an **initial payment** of \$3,333. You will receive this if you have signed up to the Maurice Blackburn administration process.
- You will be contacted shortly by the court which will distribute these payments.

FURTHER PAYMENTS TO BE DETERMINED

WHEN WILL FURTHER PAYMENTS BE MADE?

The second wave of additional penalty payments will be made after the compensation process is completed.

The calculation process is complex but the administrator Maurice Blackburn is aiming to have the compensation calculations finalised in the first half of 2026.

HOW MUCH WILL WORKERS RECEIVE?

The amount that you will receive in the second wave will be proportional to the amount you receive under the compensation scheme once your individual loss is calculated.

While these further initial penalty payments of \$3,333 will be provided to workers as soon as possible, the remainder of the payments are anticipated to take some months still. Congrats to each and every worker who has fought so hard to bring us to this outcome ahead of Christmas.
