With Enterprise Agreement bargaining kicking off this week, it's the perfect time for a reminder of what our Virgin members have already made crystal clear:

Reduced duty hours are the top priority and **we are not going to back down from that fight.**

What's already been endorsed

Last year, members **overwhelmingly** supported a clear and reasonable claim to improve safety, fatigue and quality of life at work.

Endorsed duty hours fight

- 10 hours maximum rostered duty
- 12 hours maximum in extension

This position is not new but more importantly, it's **driven by members.**



Why this matters

Excessive duty hours continue to put an unacceptable strain on cabin crew. Reducing hours is all about protecting ourselves, our colleagues and our passengers. **It restores the limits that reflect the actual realities of the job.**

- Reinforce what matters most to you in bargaining

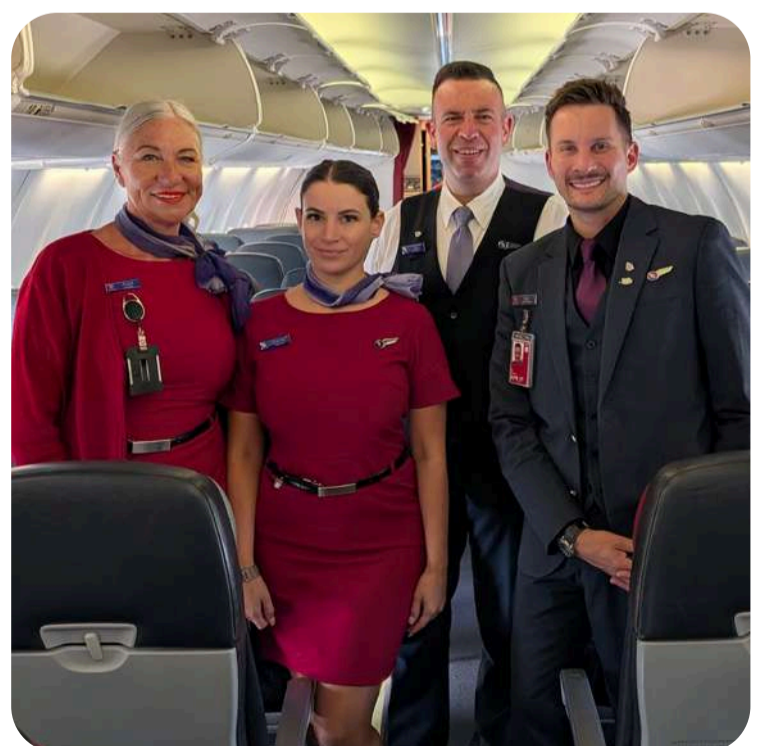
Virgin will also be releasing its half-year financial results **this Friday**
