Meanwhile, delegates from aviation, including cabin crew, will travel to Canberra to let our nation's leaders know, we **MUST** lift standards across the industry.



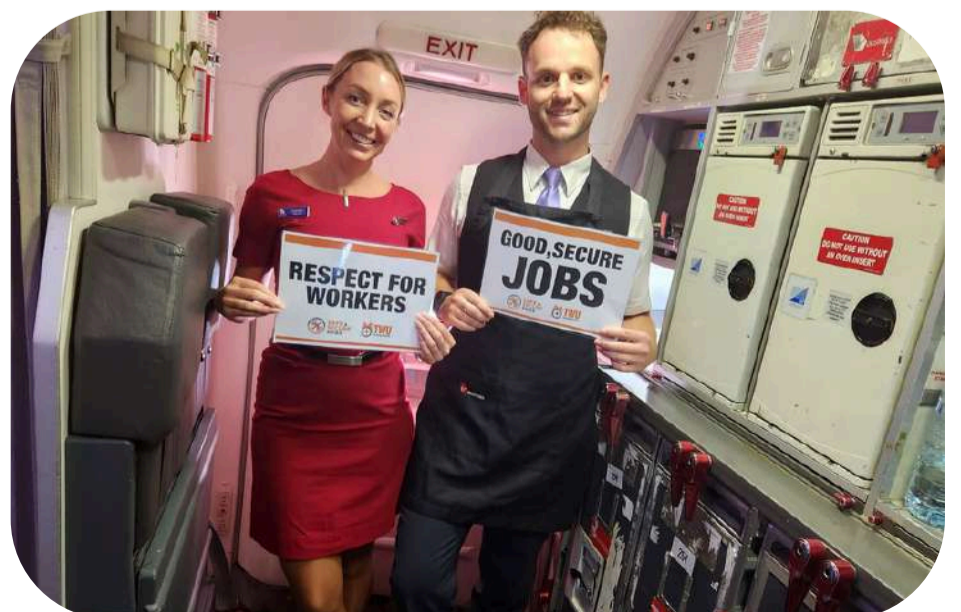
A year of action

Our application

Cabin crew pay and conditions have declined throughout the years due to:

- Gender undervaluation
- Increases to work duties and responsibilities without changes to pay

We are proposing the following changes to the award rate:

Classification	Current Award rate (per ordinary hour)	Proposed % increase	Proposed rate (per ordinary hour)
Cabin crew trainee	N/A	+10%	\$30.33
Cabin crew	\$27.57	+40%	\$38.59
Cabin crew supervisor	\$32.17	+30%	\$41.82
Cabin crew manager 1	\$37.57	+20%	\$45.08
Cabin crew manager 2	\$37.57	+30%	\$48.84

We're also applying for:

Improved classifications

Introducing a training rate and a second cabin manager classification to recognise responsibilities

Fairer duty hours

Duty hours reduced to 10 for domestic and regional flying.

Meal breaks

Improved rights to meal breaks, and overtime if meal breaks are missed

Annual leave loading

Annual leave loading to be paid on ALL leave
