

Member Update: Boolgeeda (OCM) Overnight Allowance

TWU and Virgin Australia have both indicated that neither party wishes to delay an increase to the allowance being paid for overnighing at Boolgeeda (OCM).

As a direct result of TWU members challenging the original and inadequate \$69 allowance, **the hard-lying allowance has increased to \$111.69, which will be in place from this week** while TWU and Virgin continue final discussions aimed at settling the dispute.

TWU is still fighting for more

The allowance has moved from the unsatisfactory \$69 originally proposed by the FAAA and implemented by VA, and we are hopeful we are closer to resolution.

- TWU members are clear that this allowance must sit above the allowance set out in the Aircraft Cabin Crew Award (\$111.69), which establishes only minimum standards.

*Virgin cabin crew have collectively fought to secure conditions above Award minimums. This impromptu hard-lying allowance for overnighing in Boolgeeda **should be no different.***

This issue goes beyond Boolgeeda.

As part of the EA7 log of claims, TWU members are negotiating for:

- an above Award hard-lying allowance
- additional protections in the next EA, including clear rules and safeguards when crew are required to stay in non-hotel or mine-site accommodation.

Feedback is continuing to be provided on the claim details.
