

Virgin Cabin Crew Bargaining Update Bargaining Meeting #3

This week, TWU bargaining reps met with Virgin Australia for the latest cabin crew bargaining meeting.

At this meeting, we put forward key claims, including a proposed new classification structure and changes to progression of pay. Virgin has now provided its first response to our Log of Claims. Put simply, it was pretty limited.

Virgin indicated they could potentially agree to only a couple of items. The majority of our claims have been placed into **categories like:**

- “ Still being reviewed
- “ Requires further costing
- “ Unlikely to agree

This includes major issues that matter deeply to cabin crew — such as getting back our **10 DDOs per roster** — which the company already knows is one of the biggest priorities for members.

While we are still early in bargaining, this response shows exactly **why member unity and pressure will be critical** to winning real change in this agreement. TWU is now working through Virgin's pushback to identify the key pressure points we need to focus on together.
