FIRST MEETING



Your TWU member-led negotiating team has met with Centurion for the first round of negotiations. A number of key claims have already been rejected. The company has not responded to your wage claim. In response to claims for conditions, Centurion are offering only the minimum entitlements required by law.

YOUR KEY CLAIMS

Centurion thinks they can get away with giving you bare minimum conditions. The message is clear, it's time to close the gap with other major transport companies who do the same sort of work.
