

K&S REFUSES NATIONAL AGREEMENT TO LIFT STANDARDS

TWU members have made their voices heard around claims for bargaining a fair agreement in 2026, one of the biggest opportunities we've had as a union to significantly increase pay and conditions across the industry.

WE'VE BEEN PUSHING FOR A NATIONAL AGREEMENT

A national agreement:

- Gives workers more power to fight together to lift standards
- Ensures companies can't pit workers against each other
- Lifts everyone up together

But K&S is refusing to listen to workers.

Other major transport companies have sensibly agreed to national agreements which not only improves workers' power to bargain together but lessens time spent negotiating dozens of separate agreements.
