

OUR LETTER TO SWISSPORT CEO FOR SECURE WORK

Last week, following hundreds of workers signing a claim for **secure work** at Swissport, we wrote a letter to CEO Tony Filacouridis calling for:

1. Increase contracted hours for workers who are regularly working hours equivalent to full-time employment.
2. Establish a transparent and fair expression of interest process for workers seeking conversion to full-time employment.
3. Commit to secure, permanent full-time jobs where work is regular, systematic and ongoing.
