Hearings begin this week at the Fair Work Commission on the TWU's application for minimum standards in the last mile sector.

Ending the 'Amazon Effect'

For too long, companies like Amazon have undercut good employers through gig-like work, piecemeal rates and impossible delivery schedules, incentivising companies like FedEx into a race to the bottom.

This application will help establish a fairer playing field, protect secure jobs and responsible employers, and ensure workers aren't forced to rush, cut corners or risk their safety just to earn a pay check.
