

WIN: QUBE WORKERS VOTE NO TO ANOTHER DODGY QUBE AGREEMENT

Qube's strategy to rush through dodgy site-based agreements has failed as Qube workers stand united.

Workers at the VIC West Melbourne, NSW MCS and NSW Carrington sites have all voted NO in recent weeks - sending a clear message to Qube that workers will not be forced into another agreement which leaves them behind the rest of the industry.



WORKERS ARE STANDING TOGETHER TO FIGHT FOR:

- ▶ **One consolidated agreement** to close the gap across NSW, VIC and QLD Qube sites covering over 600 workers.
- ▶ **A 2029 June expiry aligned with the rest of the industry** so Qube workers can keep lifting pay and standards in line with the rest of the industry.
- ▶ **Stronger rights and conditions**, including better job security, stronger leave entitlements, voice at work including improved representation and consultation rights, and superannuation lifted to 15%.
- ▶ **Strong Pay increases that close the gap** with other major transport operators and keep up with the cost of living.

- ▶ Congratulations to all union members on standing strong and united in face of Qube's games.
- ▶ Your member-led TWU negotiating committee will give Qube every opportunity in the coming week to start engaging seriously and in good faith with our claims.
- ▶ At the same time, we will begin filing **Protected Action Ballots (PABs)** to increase pressure on Qube and ensure we are prepared to take further action if Qube refuses to do so.
