For years, TWU members fought for a Safe & Secure Skies Commission to rebuild aviation and ensure decisions are made in the public interest.

Today, **we're one major step closer** with Labor embedding it in its platform.



Aviation Council Announced

The Federal Labor Government has officially committed to establishing an **Aviation Industry Coordination Council** to:

- ✓ Coordinate and **strengthen aviation industry standards**
- ✓ **Identify gaps** and implement new standards where needed
- ✓ **Work collaboratively** with airlines, airports, workers, regulators and government
- ✓ Ensure **balanced decision-making** that serves the Australian community, including regional Australia
- ✓ **Strengthen resilience**, especially during times of crisis
- ✓ **Resolves disputes** between industry participants
