



UPDATE - QANTAS COMPENSATION



TWU members this week attended the Federal Court, with Justice Lee setting a hearing date for next **Thursday 6 August** on Maurice Blackburn (the administrator's) finalisation of the compensation process, which has taken additional time given its scale and complexity.

We know workers want to receive compensation as quickly as possible after years of being dragged through the courts by Qantas.

We are pushing for the process to be expedited as much as possible, while still ensuring it retains its integrity, and workers receive the full compensation they are entitled to under the judgment.

ALAN JOYCE'S RETURN NOT SO TRIUMPHANT

You might have seen coverage over the last few days of Alan Joyce spruiking his new memoir, in an attempted redemption tour across the Australian media landscape.
