

NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE #3: DHL STILL DENYING FAIR WAGE INCREASE



Your TWU member-led negotiations committee met with DHL for the third round of negotiations, where DHL continued to **deny workers a fair wage increase**.

DHL's wage offer still leaves workers below cost of living increases since 2022 by almost 5%, which will essentially send you backwards.

18.5% pay increase	Year 2:	3.5% or CPI

- ✗ **Family & Domestic Violence leave** or Parental Leave provisions
- ✗ **Labour hire or contractor ratios** to permanent employees
- ✓ **Expiry Date:** 30 June 2029
- ✓ **Framework for one National Agreement** next negotiations
- ✓ **Union building:** Delegates training leave, inductions and quarterly yard meetings
- ✓ **Consultation and Dispute Resolution**—including all matters & status quo provisions
- ✓ **Clause to address consultation on Future of Work**, including AI & Automation implementation
- ✓ **Increase in Redundancy:** All workers moving across to the DHL entitlement
