

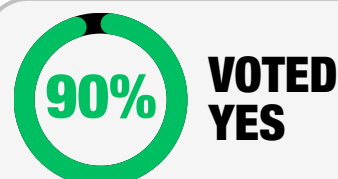
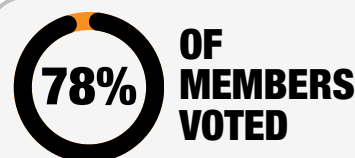
HUGE YES RESULT ON PROTECTED ACTION



Border Express TWU members across multiple sites in Queensland, Victoria and South Australia have **stood up**, voting with overwhelming support to take protected industrial action if management doesn't come to the table to settle a fair agreement.

The message to Border Express is clear. **The offer on the table is not good enough** and workers will stand together and take action for a better deal.

While members have voted massively over this week, your member-led committee will be back at the negotiating table soon to take all steps to settle outstanding issues:

- 1. One National Agreement** to lift everyone up together
- 2. A fair pay offer** that closes the gap between transport companies
- 3. Job Security** and union provisions

- ▶ Delegates and organisers will be in touch for next steps, including potential action.
