

NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE: BUILDING TOWARDS AN INDUSTRY-WIDE AGREEMENT



dnata and Menzies have committed to pursuing a Multi-Employer Agreement (MEA), an agreement that can set a level playing field of standards across the industry, and help stop companies like Swissport and Star Aviation from undercutting good employers.

But before we can get there, we need to lock in a strong dnata agreement that protects your current standards and delivers improvements. Here is what they have put on the table:

WHAT'S IN DNATA'S OFFER?

- ▶ **Fill vacancies within 3 months**, with internal workers considered first
- ▶ **Aim for at least 7 days notice for shift changes**, unless there are operational requirements
- ▶ **Improve process for fixing payroll errors**, including a **penalty payment**
- ▶ **Move workers to a higher classification**, when they perform higher duties for 3 months, except in defined circumstances
- ▶ **Automatically approve annual leave** if the company doesn't respond within 14 days
- ▶ **Pay workers who attend a work-related meeting outside their rostered hours**

DNATA'S WAGE OFFER

TOTAL Over 3 years 9% base rate increase* *annual increase equates to 3.2% per year over life of agreement when first pay increase brought forward by one month	Year 1:	3%	(1 month ahead of current agreement expiry)
	Year 2:	3%	(+0.25% if CPI is above 3.2%)
