

FEDEX LAUNCHES INSULTING ATTACK ON WORKERS

The TWU was forced to call a 2-hour stoppage to respond to FedEx's attacks on joint report-backs and ongoing misinformation.

But now FedEx has launched a fresh wave of attacks on workers. It has:

- ✗ Tried to **scare and intimidate workers** by threatening to withhold backpay
- ✗ Spread **lies and misinformation** about TWU claims
- ✗ **Cancelled negotiation meetings** scheduled for next week and refused to speak to workers
- ✗ Written to the TWU to demand workers accept their '**final offer**' that was already voted down with no additional changes, or risk losing everything
- ✗ Tried to rush through a **second vote** on the agreement workers already voted down.
- ✗ Threatened to **lockout workers** participating in the stoppage tomorrow.

FedEx's US bosses are doing everything they can to bully workers and destroy Australian jobs. Tomorrow thousands of TWU members will take a stand—we will not be intimidated or back down.

And behind you there are thousands of other workers fighting to lift standards across the transport industry.

Stay strong, stay united – because when we fight, we win. It's time for FedEx to stop the threats and come back to the table with a fair offer.
