Your TWU member-led committee has met with FedEx to recommence negotiations. Workers have already voted down FedEx's dodgy deal. Since then, your committee has given the company every opportunity to come back with a fair agreement. **After two days at the negotiating table, FedEx still won't budge.**

In order to get negotiations moving again, your committee has made the tough decision to withdraw several claims and revise others, focusing the fight on what matters most to workers. FedEx responded with little more than empty words around a non-enforceable Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

No real movement on wages. No real movement on job security. No real movement on the future of work.
